
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
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#### DOWNSPOUT OUTLET TUBE

### **STEP 1**: Installing Downspout Outlet Tubes


Determine outlet locations and field cut hole in the gutter bottom. Insert Outlet Tube in hole, apply a continuous bead of urethane Tube Sealant to the flange and fasten with two (2) Pop Rivets in each flange from outside the gutter bottom.






### STEP 2 : Installing Gutter End Caps

Locate the End Caps for the appropriate gutter end. Place the End Cap into position and secure to gutter with Pop Rivets. Apply a continuous bead of urethane Tube Sealant around the inside flange of the End Cap.




### **STEP 3**: Installing Gutter Miters

Locate the Miters for the appropriate locations. Secure the Miter to the roof edge using the #10-13x1" S.S. Panhead Woodscrews (provided) every pre-punched hole or 12" o.c. maximum.




#### STEP 4: Installing Expansion Joints (If Required)

Install expansion joint in location as specified on roof plans. An expansion joint will consist of two (2) pre-fabricated End Caps, one (1) Joint Plate, and one Joint Cover. Gap the End Caps at 1" maximum. Slide the Joint Plate onto the Gutter, then secure with Pop Rivets to one of the gutter ends. Place the Joint Cover over the End Cap lips and secure with Pop Rivets to only one of the gutter ends.




**STEP 5**: Installing Gutter HD Straight Lengths

Begin from the End Caps/Miters working inward to the center. Allow  $\frac{1}{8}$  " gap between Gutter sections for thermal expansion. Secure gutter to roof with #10-13x1" S.S. Panhead Woodscrews (Provided) at 12" on center in each pre-punched hole.



#### **STEP 6**: Installing Gutter HD Joint Splices

Locate the joint splice and apply a continuous bead of urethane Tube Sealant to both sides of the joint inside the gutter. Slide the Splice Plate down into the gutter and secure with Pop Rivets on the up slope side of the splice as shown in Figure #1 and #2.



### **STEP 7**: Installing Gutter HD Brackets

Hook the top part of the Gutter HD Bracket into the face lip of the gutter. Rotate the bracket down into the gutter and secure the bracket through the gutter, into the treated wood nailer, with one (1) #9-13x1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " S.S. Woodscrew. Install brackets at 24" on center maximum. Install roof membrane into Gutter per roof manufacturer's instructions.
